We wish to bring to the attention of the reader the following errors in the printed volume:

p. 129, lines 22-23

read: appointing Carathéodory's successor *instead of:* Carathéodory's appointment

p. 181, line 10

read: contract of faith *instead of:* symbol of self-confidence

p. 262, lines -8, -7

Carathéodory's daughter says that his "dismissal" was typed on half a page ...

p. 273, lines -6, -5

read: can be fixed at the beginning *instead of:* can be at the beginning

p. 301, line 2

read: 1933 *instead of:* 1935

p. 301, line 13

read: were less than *instead of:* were less under

p. 302, line 12

read: Arnold Scholz *instead of:* Heinrich Scholz

p. 381, line 23 (Schauder's letter)

read: I am *instead of:* I have am

p. 389, lines 19-21

read: Though appointed by Venizelos himself, he had resigned his position *instead of:* been dismissed) and naturally avoided trumpeting the fact in Germany.

p. 391, line -14

read: seems not to have been aware *instead of:* seems not to have not been aware

p. 430, lines 8-12

read: The Greek diplomat and politician Thomas Ypsilantis had belonged to the Greek diplomatic corps since 1935 and would serve as Ambassador of Greece in Bonn from 1959 to 1961.⁷¹ *instead of:* Ypsilantis would not be useful to Carathéodory ... Carathéodory's wishes.

p. 467, line 9

read: work on functions of real variables *instead of:* functions of real functions.

p. 559

Add to note 342 : A couple of days after the completion of his reform work, Papandreou was replaced by P. Petridis in the new government under Venizelos (5 June 1932). A few days later, Carathéodory resigned (and was not dismissed from) his office of Commissioner of the Greek Government and returned to Munich. He was succeeded by N. Alivizatos, Professor of Surgery at the University of Athens, who retained this position up to 6 April 1933, when the office of commissioner was abolished by decree (Government Gazette 88, A).
