Ramon Agustí, (M'78) received this PhD in Telecommunication Engineering from the Universitat Politècnica de Catalunya (UPC), Spain, in 1978 and he became Full Professor in 1987. For the last fifteen years, has been mainly concerned with the mobile communication systems. He has published more than a hundred fifty papers in these areas. He participated in the European program COST 231 and COST 259 as Spanish representative delegate as well as in the RACE, ACTS, IST and currently FP6 projects European research programs. In this time he has also been advisor of Spanish and Catalanian Governmental Agencies (DGTel, CICYT, ANEP and CIRIT) on issues concerning radio and mobile communications. "He received the *Salvó y Campillo* Prize awarded to the best Engineer of 1997 in Catalonia and the *Narcís Monturiol* Prize issued by the Catalanian Government in 2002 in reconnaissance of the task carried out in the mobile communication field. His actual research interest includes Radio Networks, Wireless Access Protocols, Radio Resources Management and QoS.
