

Preface

This volume contains the papers presented at ICCCS 2016: the Second International Conference on Cloud Computing and Security held during July 29–31, 2016, in Nanjing, China. The conference was hosted by the College of Computer and Software at the Nanjing University of Information Science and Technology, who provided the wonderful facilities and material support. We made use of the excellent EasyChair submission and reviewing software.

The aim of this conference is to provide an international forum for the latest results from research, development, and applications in the field of cloud computing and information security.
