I confess: this version is much better than the very first one which I naively considered perfect. Being shepherded for the second time (Cope was the shepherd for our workshop proposal), I can say: it's hard, sometimes fun, but always helpful!

Re: ETHOS4.rtf

First, I have subdivided the pattern sections wherever appropriate (instructor's vs. learner's perspective). I will follow your advice and encourage some of my students who have been through a complete course structured along the ETHOS lines to feedback on this.

Second, I have restored the INTENT section because I won't irritate people from the pedagogical patterns project. However, I will feedback our concerns regarding the missing section for a clear problem statement to the project leader Mary Lynn Manns.

Third and last, this version is not based on the file you've edited. I have tried to spot your corrections and transferred them to this version. However, my "blind spot" of writing could have fooled me, so please have a fresh look at my spelling, grammar and Germanisms. The English of this paper should be better than SEE: Standard Euro-English ;-)
