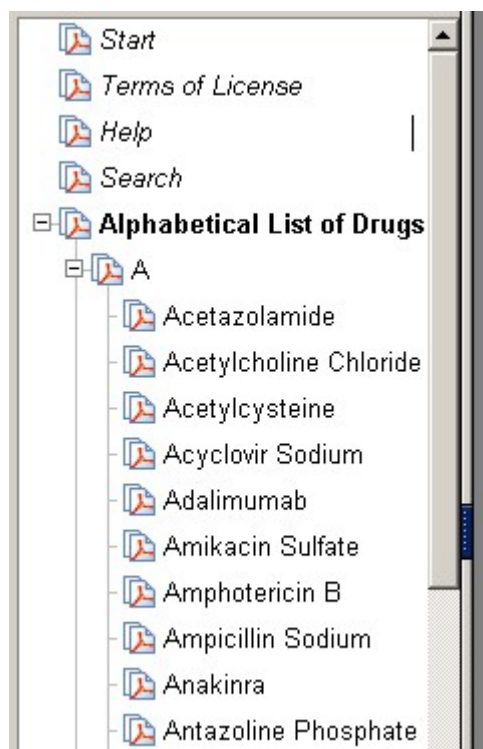

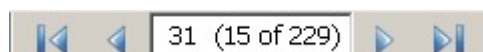

To navigate inside the document you are viewing there are these buttons at the bottom of the Acrobat Reader window.

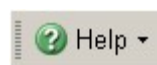
Use the icons (from left to right) to go to

- the first page
- the previous page
- the next page
- the last page.
- last view
- next view



Use these buttons on top of the Acrobat Reader window to resize or fit size and width of the Acrobat Reader window.

By pressing this button you'll get the Acrobat Reader Help.



For users of the PDA-version the reflow-button could be helpful. On small handheld or PDA displays this reflow functions allows reading without having a horizontally scrolling each line.
