

Morphological sequelae

1. Splenomegaly
2. Portacaval collateral circulation
3. Formation of hepatic lymphocysts
4. Portal hypertensive intestinal vasculopathy
 - portal hypertensive gastropathy
 - portal hypertensive colonopathy

Haemodynamic sequelae

1. Elevated cardiac output
2. Lowered peripheral resistance
3. Elevated heart rate
4. Lowered arterial blood pressure

Pathophysiological sequelae

1. Reduced detoxification of noxae
2. Impaired biotransformation
3. Coagulation disorders
4. Hepatopulmonary syndrome
5. Endocrine and metabolic disorders
6. Disposition to bacterial infections
7. Insufficiency of lymph drainage
8. Ascites
