8.7.4 Assessment Form for the Hand – Abduction of the Digits

This form is mainly used for adults who only have webbing without any flexion contracture. It cannot be used during growth because the length and the abduction of the fingers correlate with each other.

The abduction of the fingers can be measured from the tip of the middle finger to the fingers on either side. The distance between the index finger and the little finger can also be measured. The distance between the thumb and the little finger gives the full spread of the hand.
